## Questions to discuss in our Growth Groups and personal reflection

Read John 17:20-26.

### 1. Jesus prayed that our unity would be a witness to the world

What magnificent relationship does Jesus welcome us into?

How are Christian relationships to image the relationship of the Trinity?

Why is our unity (or lack of it) a witness to the world? What is important for us a church in maintaining unity with each other?

### 2. Jesus prayed that it would be clear that God loves us as he loves Jesus

How much does God the Father love Jesus the Son?

How much does God the Father love us who are “in Christ”?

Why is it hard to accept that God loves us this much?

How would our lives be transformed if we really believed it??

### 3. Jesus prayed that we would be with him and enjoy his glory

Where would you most like to be right now?

Where does Jesus ultimately want you to be and why?

How can we make the most of life on earth at the same time as desiring to be with Christ most of all?

- That we would receive the Father's love as He offers it to us.
- That our security in Jesus would make all the difference in our lives.
- That our unity with the Trinity would be reflected in the unity we share with each other at PBC.
