Questions to discuss in our Growth Groups and personal reflection

1. Will our generation pass on the praiseworthy deeds of the LORD?

Read Judges 2:6-10.

Describe Joshua as a man, a leader, and the effect he had on the nation?

Whilst Joshua's generation are described positively here, what do we know about them from Chapter 1 after Joshua had died?

What is the marked change in the generation that followed (v.10)?

What are some of the possible causes for a generation turning from God?

What responsibility should the following take & how can we pray for them?

- Christian parents
- Church leaders and teachers
- The whole church

2. Will our generation break cycles of sin with Christ's help?

Read Judges 2:11-19.

What cycle became the pattern of Israel's existence for the next 3-400 years?

How do the judges point to a greater salvation that ultimately Jesus fulfilled?

Even as Christians, why do we still sin? How does Jesus help us to break those cycles? How can being in an accountable relationship with another Christian also make a real difference?

3. Will our generation fight with God in the midst of battle?

Read Judges 2:20 – 3:6.

How did God intend to use the presence of Israel's enemies for their good (see 2:22, 3:2 & 3:4)?

How does 1 Peter 2:11-12 describe the battle God has given us to fight with Him? What does this look like for you?
