Questions for our Growth Groups and personal reflection

Read Isaiah 60 all the way through.

1. God's transformation brings light out of darkness

What was the light that was rising upon the people of Jerusalem in verses 1&2, and why did they need it?

How does 2 Corinthians 4:6 explain God bringing light through Jesus?

Why might we still exclude Jesus from some of the 'dark places' of our hearts?

How might the image in verse 3 fuel us to pray for the lost – whether it be world leaders or people in our community?

Why does John in Revelation 21:23 use the imagery about light from Isaiah 60:19-20? How should it encourage us?

2. God's transformation rebuilds from the ruins

What are some of the ways God would restore the fortunes of Jerusalem as shown in this chapter?

What does the LORD want His people to know (v.16)?

Can you share any stories of how Jesus has rebuilt an aspect of your life from ruins?

Read Revelation 21:25 – why will the gates of the heavenly city never be shut?

What hopes did God give His people in verses 21-22?

How can you be sure that God will complete what He has started in your life?
