Jesus loves the little children

- 1. Children were of worth to God even when others didn't see them like that. Are there people you see as being less worthy? Why? How can you change this into a more positive attitude?
- 2. Why were the disciples stopping the children coming to Jesus? What does this say about the disciples? Do you think there is anyone who is beyond God's reach?

Childish or childlike

- 3. It's easy to make things more complicated than they are. Is there an area of your life where you need to get back to more simple ways?
- 4. "The kingdom of God belongs to such as these". God calls us to see Him through a child's eyes. What do we need to do for this to happen?
- 5. "Seeing is believing". But faith is different. How would you describe 'faith' to someone outside 'church-world'?

- 6. Why can being born again and being credited with Jesus' righteousness only happen once?
- 7. And why is becoming like Christ an ongoing process?
- 8. How are transformation and unity linked? Can you have one without the other?
- 9. The process of becoming more like Jesus involves setting aside and setting apart. Is there anything in your life that you need to set aside to become more set apart for Jesus?
