Questions for our Growth Groups and personal reflection

1. Come, all you who are thirsty (v.1-5)

What wonderful invitations have you received that you were glad to accept?!

What is the invitation God gives in verse 1 and how is it contrasted with what the Israelites had been seeking in verse 2?

How far and wide will God's invitation extend, and how is this fulfilled through Jesus (v.3-5)?

How does Jesus satisfy 'hungry' and 'thirsty' people? What does this look like in your experience?

2. Seek the LORD while he may be found (v.6-11)

Does God want to be found? On what basis can people find him (see v.6-7)?

How are God's thoughts and ways so different from ours (v.8-9)? – see the context of these verses!

How does this further help us see Christ's heart for sinners and sufferers?

As people need something deeper than the shallowness of the world's offerings, let's pray for those who don't yet know Christ – including the many who have had contact with our church over the past 20+ years, to seek Him!

3. You will go out in joy (v.12-13)

What will be transformed through God's salvation?
