The Lord will show us what to do (v.1-3)

Why was Samuel mourning for Saul?

Do we mourn over our own sins, the sins of other Christians, and failures of churches who carry the name of Jesus?

As with Samuel in identifying God's chosen king, are you facing a challenge where you need to trust that our Sovereign God:

- 1. Sees everything more clearly than us?
- 2. He has chosen a way to provide for you?
- 3. And He will show you what to do?

Despite all that Samuel knew about the character flaws of Saul despite his impressive appearance, why did he see Eliab and immediately think that he was the one?

In what circumstances or decisions are we sometimes tricked into judging by first impressions/appearances? Why are in danger of repeatedly making this mistake?
