Questions for Growth Groups and personal reflection – week starting 12th April 2026.

“Build for what will last.”

Read Luke 6 verses 46-49.

1. You’ve come into £1million. How would you spend it? What about £100? £10?
2. The two builders each built a house.
 - a. What was the same about the two houses?
 - b. What was different?
 - c. Why might the builders have differed in the way they built their houses?
3. The same storm hit both houses. What does the storm signify (read 1 John 4 verses 17-18 to help)?
4. What do we mean when we talk about being a ‘steward’?
5. Luther and Wesley both said that “the last part of a [person] to be converted is their wallet.” Discuss!
6. What can we learn about letting go of false gods from the experience of Israel as recorded in the Old Testament?
7. If “the measure of faith is not what you give but what you keep”, how do you work out how much to give to God’s treasury?
8. God calls us to work for Him. In what ways can we do this, how will God equip us to carry out His work, and what is the result of working for Him?
