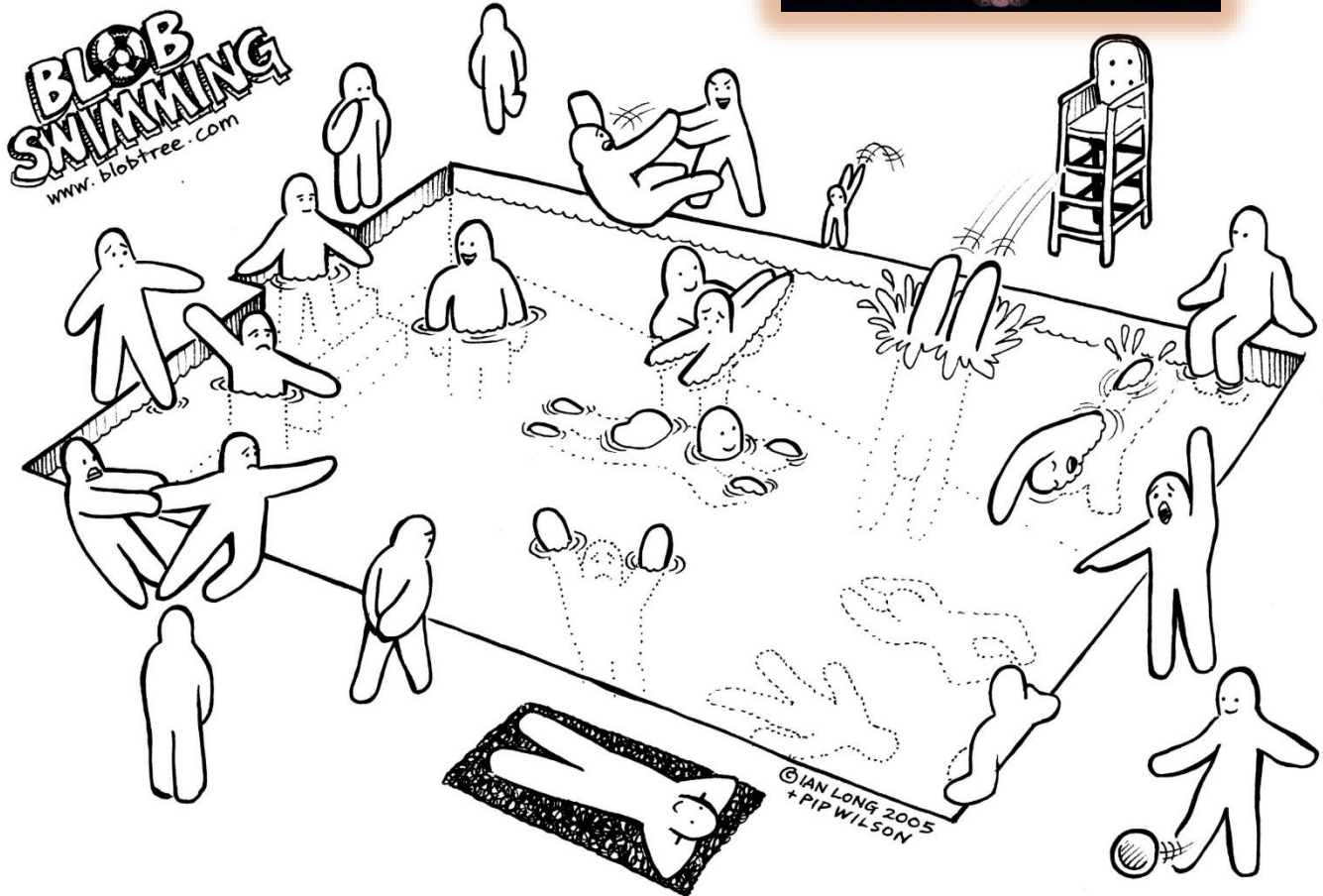




**Lord's Supper celebration

If you were in this swimming pool, might any of these people get in your way?

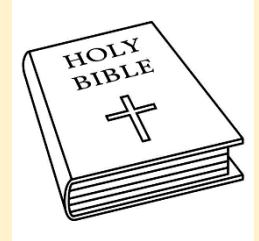
Are there any you think you might need to speak to about their behaviour?

**"BEAR WITH ONE ANOTHER IN LOVE"**

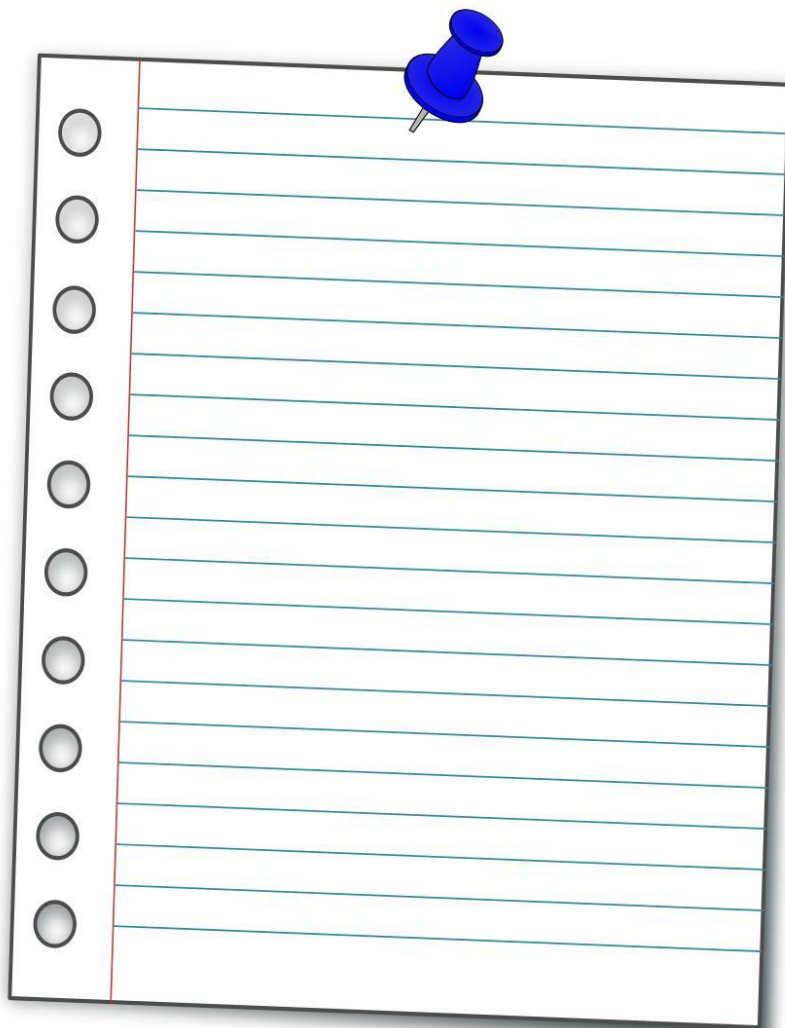
