






# SUNDAY 13<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER PSALMS 1 & 2 "BLESSED IS THE ONE"



Psalms 1 & 2 are like "two grand pillars, one on each side of the entrance gate into the 5 books of psalms" (Christopher Ash)

#### PSALM 1 - Blessed is the One:

- What is the picture given that describes being blessed (v.3)? Draw or write it here:



- What will happen to the wicked (v.4)?
- Where will the wicked not end up (v.5)?



two ways to live

#### PSALM 1 questions and prayer points for the week ahead:

- ? How would you describe how someone moves from being 'wicked' to being 'righteous', and why is this a life of 'blessing'?
- ? How does knowing Jesus transform our view of the Bible (= 'law of the LORD')? How do you feel about Scripture?
- ? What marks of a righteous person are 'growing' like fruit in your life? What temptations or pressures do you find it difficult to resist?

#### Pray:


- > Praise God that Jesus is the blessed One who brings God's blessing to the world
- Pray for yourself and our church to trust in Jesus for our righteousness, rather than trying to make ourselves righteous
- > Pray for God's protection for us against the sin of the world which tries to trick us into believing that blessing is to be found through its values



### Psalm 2 – God's Son the King:

- What is the desire of the people of the world (v.1-3)?
- Why is their plotting in vain (v.4-6)?







## PSALM 2 questions and prayer points for the week ahead:

- ? In what ways do you see the world wanting to break free from God? In what ways do you do this too?
- ? How should verses 4-9 give us confidence in God's power and Jesus' rule as His anointed king, even when the world seems chaotic?
- ? How will psalms 1 and 2 shape the way you read all the psalms going forward?

#### Pray:

- Thank God that He remains in charge of all things, and that Jesus is the true King of the World
- Pray that, as you trust Jesus, you would "Serve the LORD with fear and celebrate his rule with trembling" (v.11)
- Pray for a world in rebellion against God, that there might be humility from world leaders and a submission to the LORD
