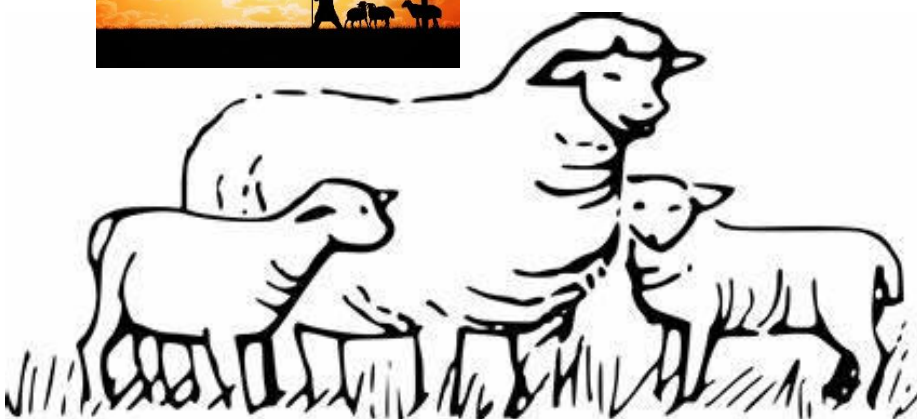
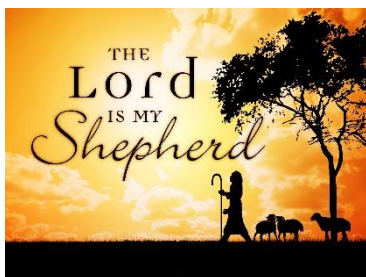


The Lord's Supper – Sunday 27th December 2020

“Yahweh Rohi” – The LORD is my Shepherd

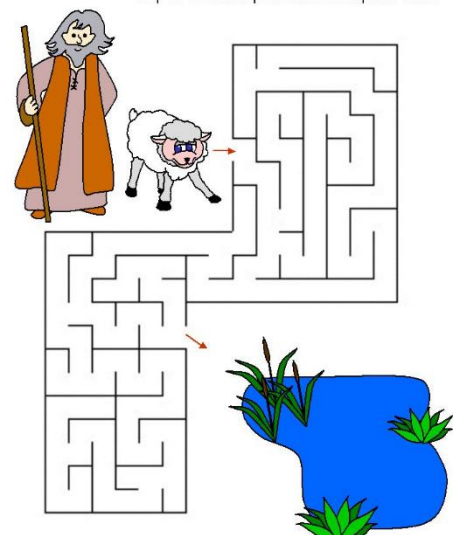
Enjoy a meal and answer the questions below as you reflect on the year past.
If you're eating with others, discuss together over dinner

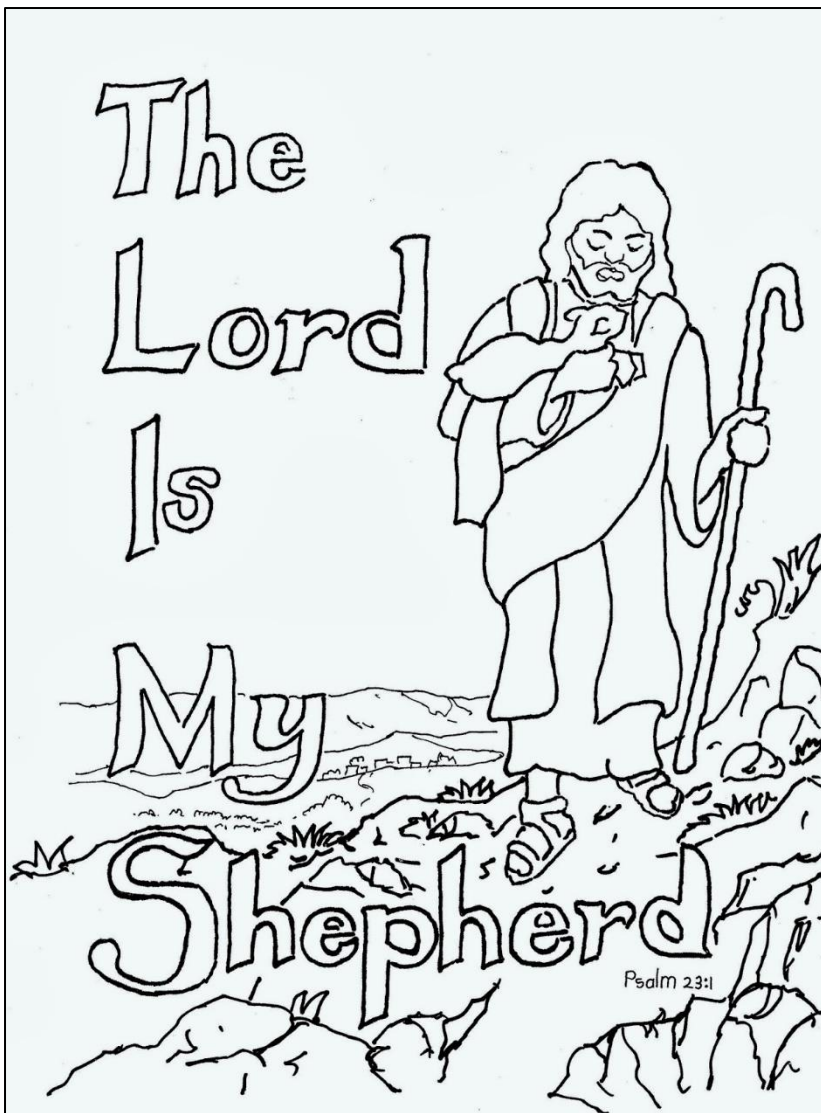
1. What has been challenging, but also what opportunities has God given you in 2020?

Psalm 23

1. David was praying to a covenant God – Yahweh
2. David lacked nothing with the LORD as his shepherd
3. God was bringing David to a place of rest and plenty
4. God often took David through dark places on the way – but protected him from fearing evil
5. David knew a victory banquet awaited him, in the LORD's presence
6. Jesus prayed psalm 23 – experiencing the cross, the resurrection, and glory!
7. This is our journey if we are in Christ, our Good Shepherd!

Reflection questions for prayer:

- What characteristic of the LORD as our shepherd do you most appreciate? What other qualities of Him might you meditate on and praise Him for?
- From the journey through this psalm, and from Jesus' sacrifice for you, how might you know God's deep love for you as one treasured by Him?
- How will you seek to recognise, listen to, and respond to the shepherd's voice in 2021?
- In what ways might you pray more for the church as a 'flock' who are loved by the Good Shepherd, rather than simply praying for individuals?
