

## Questions to think and pray through this week

Why is the issue of suffering probably the biggest challenge to our faith in an all-powerful and completely loving God?

What two different causes of suffering are examples in this passage? Is either one harder to fathom than the other?

Rather than give an answer as to why these people were killed in these particular situations, what was the point Jesus made instead?

Are people more likely to turn to God in a crisis? How should that affect how we pray for those affected by the situation in Ukraine?

Why can we have confidence in God's ability and authority to judge rightly when we think about:

- People killed in the crossfire of war?
- Children who die young, or even in the womb?

How would you use the issue of suffering to point people to hope in Jesus?
