4. How would you explain the term "born again" to a non-Christian from **John 3:1-21**?
5. The donkey had to be released to serve Jesus (**v30**). From what sort of things do we need releasing?
6. Give some examples from the Bible of people who needed being released from various issues.
7. The donkey was submissive to Jesus. Why do we find submission to God so hard sometimes?

10. What different reactions were there to Jesus in **verses 39-48**?
11. What evidence is there in our studies in Luke that Jesus is the Son of God, the Messiah?
