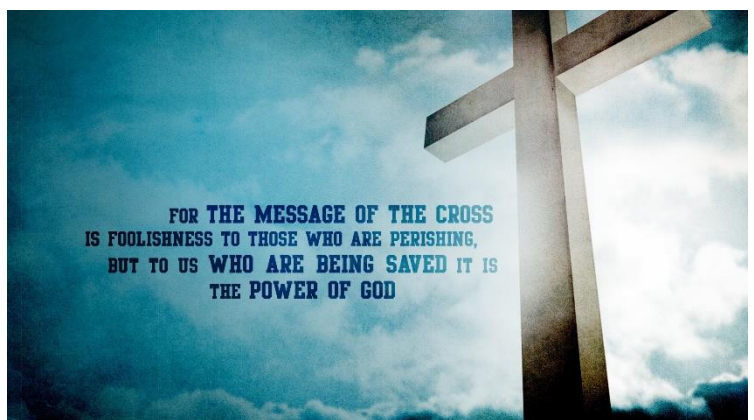
Praising God's greatness and goodness (v.3-13a)

In what ways have you, and will you, tell the next generation about the mighty acts of the LORD? Why are you doing this?

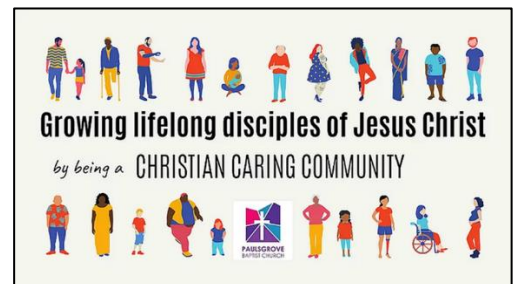
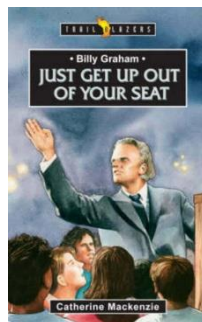
What do you hope will be the lasting impact of the witness of PBC to the next generation? Will you pray for this?!
