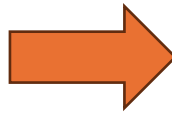

Contrasts in the Bible

“I have come into the world as a light, so that no one who believes in me should stay in darkness.”
(John 12:46)

⁸“Or suppose a woman has ten silver coins and loses one. Doesn't she light a lamp, sweep the house and search carefully until she finds it? ⁹And when she finds it, she calls her friends and neighbours together and says, “Rejoice with me; I have found my lost coin.” ¹⁰In the same way, I tell you, there is rejoicing in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents.” (John 15:8-10)

“Very truly I tell you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be judged but has crossed over from death to life” (John 5:24)

“Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: the old has gone, the new is here!” (2 Corinthians 5:17)

Which one best describes what happened to you when you put your trust in Jesus?

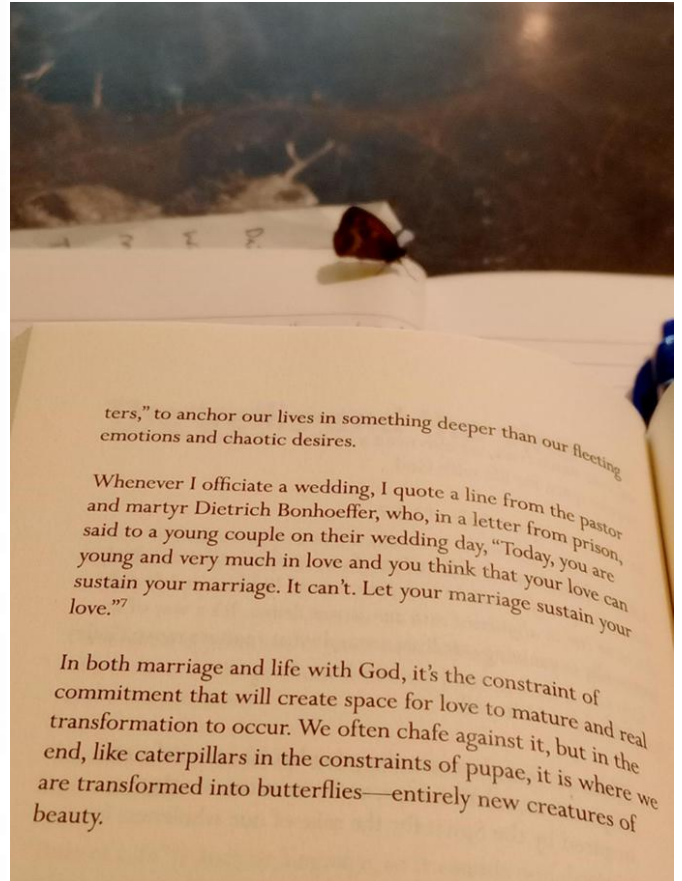
Children with Play Dough
