"Walking by Faith" Hezekiah – the determination of faith (2 Kings 18-20)

1. Godliness matters - you are not simply a product of your upbringing

"Hezekiah trusted in the Lord, the God of Israel. There was no one like him among all the kings of Judah, either before him or after him. He held fast to the Lord and did not stop following him; he kept the commands the Lord had given Moses. And the Lord was with him." (2 Kings 18:5-7)

Read 2 Kings 18:1-8

- What are some of the characteristics of Hezekiah here that you admire?
- Why was he so godly when the influence on him from his own father was not? What does this tell you about the grace of God and the determination of Hezekiah?
- Can you think of negative influences from your past that seem to have held you back in life? What do you think is the key to breaking this?
- What examples of godliness have you seen in other Christians that has inspired you to live for Jesus?

2. Prayer matters - hope is not lost if we turn to the God over all the earth (2 Kings 19)

Read 2 Kings 19:14-19

- What did Hezekiah need to remember about his situation and about God that praying enabled him to do?
- How does the very experience of praying and affirming truth about God renew our hope and faith in Him?
- How often do we wish for God to be glorified in answering our prayers, rather than simply using Him to sort out our circumstances?
- How do prayer and action go together? How do we know if we're acting in faith or in our own strength?
