- Are there times when you are embarrassed to be known as a Christian? (see verses 66-72).
- How is Mary's anointing of Jesus' feet significant? (v6-9; John12:1-8).
- The three times Mary of Bethany is mentioned in the Bible, she is at the feet of Jesus. What can we learn from her attitude?
