Questions to discuss and pray through this week

Read Daniel 2:1-30

1. What things have you been 'in the dark' about, and what was difficult about this?
2. In the initial uncertainty over the dream, mighty king Nebuchadnezzar is troubled, and young slave Daniel remains calm (v.12-16). What made the difference for Daniel, and how might his example help us when we face situations with unknown outcomes?
3. By bringing a message from God, Daniel was also introducing Nebuchadnezzar to the true and living God. Given that only half of our population actually know a Christian, what relationships has God given you with non-Christians and how are you praying and looking for opportunities to share Jesus with them?
4. As Daniel stands before the king, about to tell him the dream, he gives glory to God who revealed it to him (v.27-30). In what ways might we be tempted to take the credit for things in church/our spiritual lives? How can we make sure that God is praised for any success?

Read Daniel 2:31-49

5. What does the content of the dream tell us about the frailty of human kingdoms as opposed to God's kingdom?
6. How is Jesus the rock/stone, in the prophecy, and in what way does the cross smash all the kingdoms of the world?
7. How does this story once again thrill you both about God's sovereignty and his salvation?
