Questions for midweek discipleship growth groups

- 1. Read 1 Samuel 17
- 2. Looking at verses 4 to 7, how big a threat was Goliath?
- 3. What was the real problem? (Verse 11) What is our reaction to big problems? Run away or face them? What is the best approach?
- 4. Although the battle is the Lord's, do we play a part? How had David prepared for this moment and had God been preparing David too? (Hint: verses 34 37 and what David had written in some of the Psalms)
- 5. Why was David angry in verse 26? What place has righteous anger got?
- 6. Why was David's motives misunderstood in verse 28? How should we deal when people misunderstand us and our motives?
- 7. Why was King Saul's suggestion useless in verses 38-39? How can we make sure that we do God's work His way and not in human wisdom?
- 8. We don't have to be famous for God to use us. How is this demonstrated in verses 55 through 58? Can fame be a barrier?
- 9. Look at David's confidence in verses 45 to 47. How can we see great victories as individuals and as a church in the powerful name of Jesus?
- 10. Whatever giants you are facing, take that to God in prayer.
