Questions to discuss in our Growth Groups and personal reflection

1. Jesus is preparing a place with the Father (v.1-3)

Given all that has happened in Chapter 13, what does Jesus say to reassure his disciples in verse 1?

The disciples must have been shocked when Jesus told them he was leaving them, but was it for a negative or positive purpose (v.2-3)?

How does it make you feel to know that Jesus is *right now* preparing a place in the Father's house for you?

2. Jesus is the only way to the Father (v.4-6)

Why was Jesus confident that his disciples knew the way to the place he was going (v.4)?

What did Jesus mean in his famous statement in verse 6?

Why do you think there is a growing interest in Christianity in the UK at the moment? What should we be praying for (and doing)?

Why is following Jesus not simply about a ticket to heaven but about way of living and growing?

3. Jesus is the true revelation of the Father (v.7-14)

What did Jesus mean: "Anyone who has seen me has seen the Father" (v.9)?

Think of one unsaved person you know.

- What are their stumbling blocks and what do you think they need in order to trust in Jesus?
- How can we pray for you in your relationship with them?
