Questions for our midweek Growth Groups and personal reflection

2 Sam 15:1-17: Absalom & Ahithophel – A conspiracy within the family. What was Absalom up to, and why couldn't David see it??

Why might Ahithophel have defected and what could have been done to prevent this?

Have you experienced a family member or a friend turn against you? Were there signs you might have spotted, or an unresolved conflict that led to this?

2 Sam 15:18-22: Ittai the Gittite - The encouragement given by heartfelt friends.

Why did David give Ittai the chance to opt-out? What is remarkable about Ittai's response?

What was the impact of Ittai's friendship with David going forward (see 18:2)?

Do you have a heartfelt friend who chooses to "opt-in" when push comes to shove?

2 Sam 15:23-29: Zadok & Abiathar the priests - The confidence gained from humble friends.

What humility was displayed by Zadok & Abiathar in their response to David?

Why do quiet, consistent, humble, friends, give us such a confidence boost?

2 Sam 15:30-37: Hushai the Arkite - The victories won with heroic friends. What bravery did Hushai show in his part of God's plan?

What risks do true friends take for each other?

One who has unreliable friends soon comes to ruin, but there is a friend who sticks closer than a brother. (Proverbs 18:24)

Describe the truth in this proverb in terms of earthly friendships & with Jesus.
