Discussion questions for mid-week groups and personal reflection

1. Read John 1 vv. 29 – 42
2. Abraham and Moses were described as ‘men of faith’ (Hebrews 11). How did they show their faith in action? What can we learn about faith from their example?
3. ‘Led like a lamb to the slaughter’ (Isaiah 53 v 7): take time to think through this verse and the others around it. Stop and pray, and thank God that you are loved so much that the Creator God, the Sovereign of Heaven, died for you.
4. What did John the Baptist mean when he said that Jesus ‘has surpassed me because he came before me’?
5. Do you think that John knew Jesus before Jesus was baptised (v.31, 33)? What did John mean when he said, “I would not have known Him”?
6. Why did the two disciples follow Jesus so quickly after John proclaimed him ‘the Lamb of God’?
7. In Revelation 5 v 5-6 we see the triumphant lion in Heaven, but also as a lamb. What do the two symbolise?
8. Through what means is the Lion triumphant?
9. Use the prayer time to pray for our outreach during advent, the school Carol service on Wednesday but also and especially the church services on 24th and 25th December.
