## **Questions to discuss in our Growth Groups and personal reflection**

If you could pick any event of Jesus' life to be present at, what would it be?

Why might being with Jesus in his prayer time not be high on our list?

However, why might listening to Jesus' prayers be so insightful & helpful for us?

Read John 17:1-5.

### **1. The Father and Son always glorify each other (v.1)**

What does it mean that God is 'glorious'?

What was Jesus' greatest desire in his relationship with the Father?

What did Jesus mean that "the hour has come" and how would this bring glory to the Father and the Son?

### **2. Jesus's glorious death results in eternal life for us (v.2-3)**

What is astonishing about how Jesus uses his authority?

How does Jesus define "eternal life" and how is it both a correction to our misunderstanding as well as an encouragement about what Jesus has given us?

What do you think of this phrase by John Piper? "God is most glorified in us when we are most satisfied in Him."

### **3. God's glory is present on earth and in heaven (v.4-5)**

Knowing he would complete his work on earth, what was Jesus' longing?

How will we glorify Jesus in heaven? Why is this something for us to long for too?
