Jesus – Light of the World

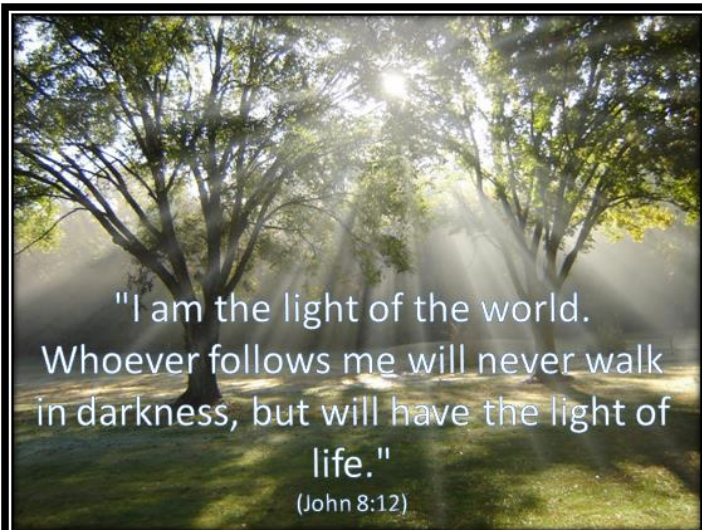

What do you think Jesus meant with these words?



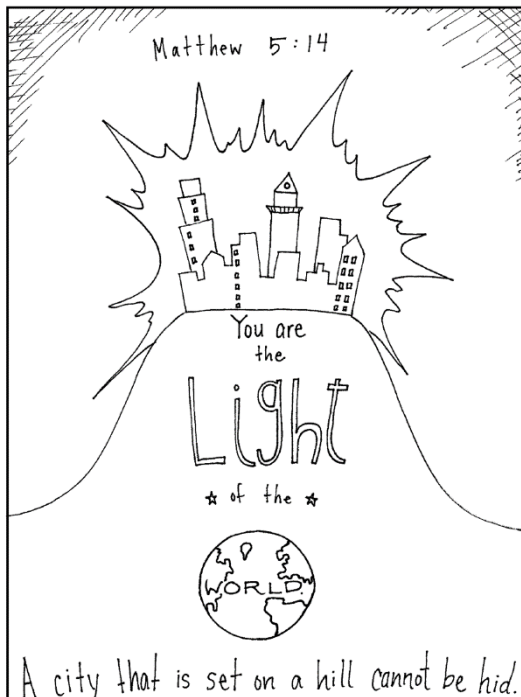
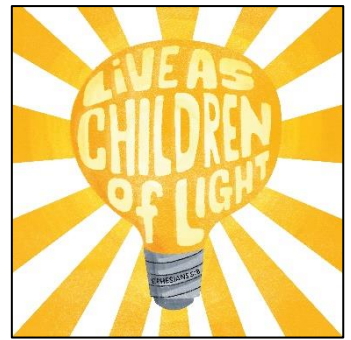
John 9 – The healing of a man born blind
