## Proverbs 5 – Sweet and Sour

- 1. Look (1-6)
  - Pay Attention, Listen well
  - It looks good but...
  - God calls us into form and freedom.
  - 'God gave us our sexuality both to focus our romantic joy and to unleash it'! (R. Ortlund jr Proverbs Wisdom that Works)
  - We live in a world of sexual foolishness.
  - 'She gives no thought to the way of life' (6)
- 2. Consider (7 19)
  - Keep to a path far from her
  - Sex is all around us. Inside and out.
  - Guard your heart it is the wellspring of life (4:23)
  - Don't tell yourself you can get involved just a bit!
  - There is a wider impact that comes from sexual folly (9-11)
  - Regret and despair (12 14)
  - A contrast is made (15 − 17)
    - Drink deeply from what is yours
    - Self control, but form and freedom
  - A prayer for his son (18 19)
- 3. Choose! (20 23)
  - Stupid is as stupid does
  - Why be captivated?
  - The Lord is observant he examines all his paths
  - Sexual wisdom is not only physical or social it is spiritual

Trapped? – There is freedom

Weak willed? – There is hope

Led astray? – There is a way back
