Proverbs 8 – 9 Choose Wisely

1. Wisdom's Call

- I am priceless 'wisdom is more precious than rubies' 1 – 11
- I am powerful 'By me Kings reign' 12 – 21
- I am the 'brain' behind creation 22 – 31
- I am the source of life 'Whoever finds me finds life' 32 - 36

2. Listen and Choose

- Listen verse 6 – We are not born wise!
- Choose Verse 10 (Take) my instructions – Act
 - Fool, Sluggard, Simple or wise?
- Wisdom is good for everyone! Verse 32 -35
- Folly is self harm

3. Wisdom's invitation 9 1- 12

- A secure house – 7 pillars hewn
- A good meal
- An invitation to the simple and those who lack judgement
 - Keep away from the mocker
- Long life and great rewards

4. Folly calls out too

- Loud, undisciplined and without knowledge
- Her guests are in the depths of the grave.

5. Standing on the threshold what will I do?

- Fool – he mocks
- The simple – chooses folly and death
- The sluggard – chooses but takes no action
- The wise – receive a garland and a chain – it is priceless!
