1. A gift that gives a firm foundation 22:6

- In a confusing world we need a firm foundation for life
- God speaks and His word has revealed 'the things that must take place'

2. A gift that shows us how to live well in a broken world 22:7

- By keeping the words of the prophecy
- So many distractions? I am coming soon
- When we invite Jesus into.... The best gift!

3. A gift that never disappoints 22:8 - 9

- John repeats his actions in 19:10 and gets the same response!
- Worship God not the messenger. God's word reveals God!

4. A gift that not everyone opens 22: 10 - 11

- Life will be a mixture of saint and sinner
- Some will not repent don't give up

5. A gift that gets better and better 22: 12 – 17

- My reward is with me
- Blessed are those who repent His life and citizenship is theirs
- Judgement will be just and true
- Judgement will be complete

6. A gift that carries a warning 22: 18 - 21

- God's word is compete and sufficient
- Don't add, don't take away

'Yes, I am coming soon!' Amen, Come Lord Jesus!
